One week left to submit abstracts!

There is still time to submit abstracts to ESCAIDE 2022 (closes Wednesday 18 May (23:59)), for an opportunity to share new findings with a large audience of public health professionals in Europe and around the world. A late-breaker abstract call will be open from 24 August—12 September for abstracts reporting data that was unavailable before the deadline for submission in the general call for abstracts for ESCAIDE.

ESCAIDE returns to Stockholm, Münchenbryggeriet

For our first hybrid event, we are keeping things familiar: the physical part of ESCAIDE will return to <u>Münchenbryggeriet</u>, a major historical building in Stockholm, in a fantastic location on the island of Södermalm, with views across the water and city. The Swapcard platform will again be used for the online experience. It will also serve to truly make the conference *hybrid* by linking the two experiences, as it will be accessible to in-person attendees through an app (and in browsers), allowing both audiences to connect with each other.
