PROJECT GOALS

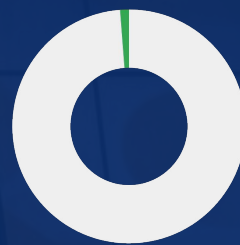
ESCAIDE 2022 is a hybrid conference organised in Stockholm, Sweden and online from 23 to 25 November 2022. In line with UN Sustainable Development goals, ECDC decided to offset carbon emissions for this event.

CARBON OFFSET CALCULATION

Carbon emissions were calculated separately for the onsite and the virtual participants

Onsite Participants

- Transportation type (plane, taxis, buses)
- Accommodation (number of guests & nights)
- Venue (size, duration, catering, etc)



• Onsite • Online

Virtual Participants

- Number of attendees
- Streaming duration
- Pre-recorded content

ESCAIDE chose a **Climate+ Portfolio** of projects, revolving around the following UN Sustainable Development Goals:

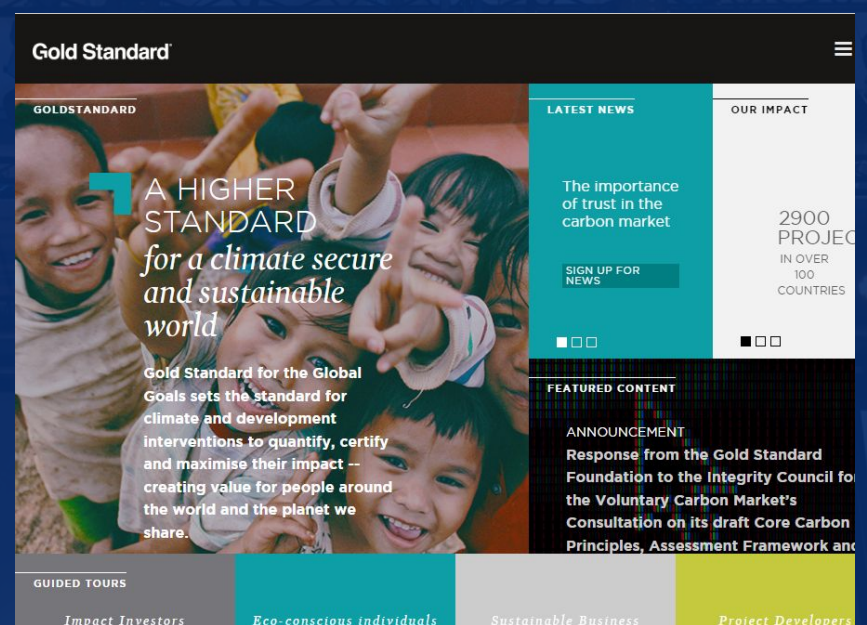


RECOMMENDATIONS

To help reduce the impact of future editions of ESCAIDE on carbon emissions, we recommend encouraging the use of trains as much as possible, reducing the number of onsite participants, developing the online side of the event, and allocating a greater budget for carbon offsetting.

Known limitations

Calculations were based on the available information. This means that some calculations are based on averages rather than exact data. This includes parameters such as the exact air travel mileage per attendee, exact local commute travel mileage per attendee, type of car (electric, diesel, petrol) and venue power source for heating (renewable, fossil, natural).
