

Privacy Statement

ECDC processes the personal data collected for the “Funding initiative at ESCAIDE 2017” processing operation in accordance with Regulation (EC) 45/2001¹. The data controller for this processing operation is Mike Catchpole, Head of Unit Office of the Chief Scientist, mike.catchpole@ecdc.europa.eu

The purpose of the processing is to provide funding opportunities to a number of ESCAIDE participants.

The categories of data collected and used for the processing operations are personal details (name and surname, address, phone number, email, nationality), employment details, submitted abstract details, participation details and a motivation statement.

The recipients of the data are:

- within ECDC: ESCAIDE team members including ESCAIDE Chair & Scientific Committee, Scientific Advice Coordination Section, Missions & Meetings, ECDC Director, Evaluation Committee for this initiative (composed of ECDC staff)
- Outside ECDC: American Express Travel Agency (AMEX), SHSCEvents (ESCAIDE project contractor)

The legal basis of the processing operation at stake is ECDC Founding Regulation 851/2004, in particular arts. 9 and 12, and the Administrative Decision of the Director of ECDC on the organisation of the European Scientific Conference on Applied Infectious Disease Epidemiology, ECDC/AD/2016/25.

Data will be retained:

- for one year from the decision on whether to provide funding or not, in case of unsuccessful applicants.
- for successful applicants, name surname and country will be kept as long as the initiative is confirmed in the subsequent years.

Please be reminded that data subjects have the right to access and rectify the information concerning them stored by ECDC. Data subjects can obtain the erasure of their data if the processing is unlawful.
